

Lodging in The White Mountains

The Appalachian Mountain Club (AMC) maintains a cabin in the heart of the White Mountains. Located at the southern end of scenic Pinkham Notch, Harvard Cabin is an excellent headquarters for skiing, snowshoeing, day hiking, bicycling, and canoeing on the Saco River, or as a "home base" for any outdoor activities.

The cabin is ideal for youth groups, group retreats, outing clubs and other users. It is in a wooded area 100 yards from parking just half way between the junction of Routes 16 & 203 and Pinkham Notch, NH. The sleeping loft accommodates up to 30 people. The kitchen is equipped with two stoves and a refrigerator to handle the preparation of group meals. The cabin is heated and toasty in winter, shaded & cool in warmer months. Cold water is supplied from a well and the outhouse is located about 50 yards from the cabin. Ample cooking & eating utensils are provided. Users bring their own sleeping bags & pads. This shared, rustic space fosters the development of friendships and group spirit – wonderful experiences not easily found at a commercial hotel.
