Directions to Jonathan Eshenour Memorial Trail



From Rt. 322 go to Bullfrog Valley Rd., 0.4 mile west of the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center. Turn south on Bullfrog Valley Rd., go 0.8 mile to the park on the right. The park is located near the western end of the Jonathan Eshenour Memorial Trail.

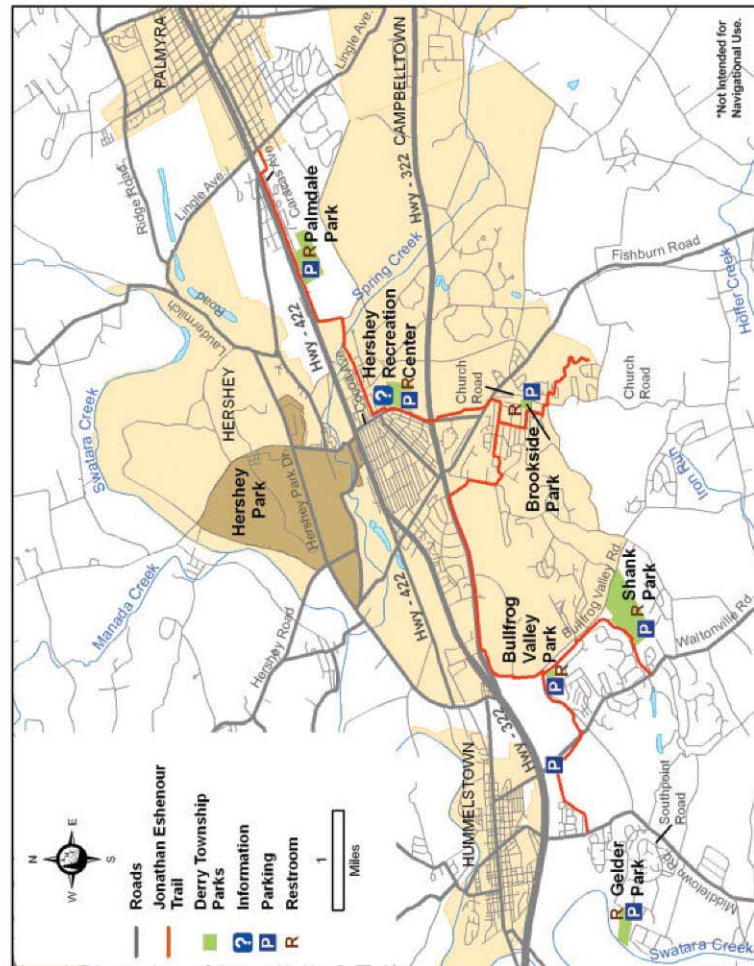
SAND HILLS CONSERVATION AREA Jonathan Eshenour Memorial Trail

Jonathan Eshenour Memorial Trail is a paved 13-mile multi-use trail named in memory of a young, vibrant community member who was fatally injured in a biking accident. The trail provides safe family-friendly recreation. It travels through Derry Township in Dauphin County and is located near township parks and town centers. Hikers and bikers can experience settings from natural areas, to farmlands to neighborhoods. Additional hiking trails can be found at nearby Shank Park.

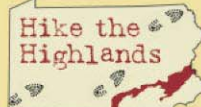
