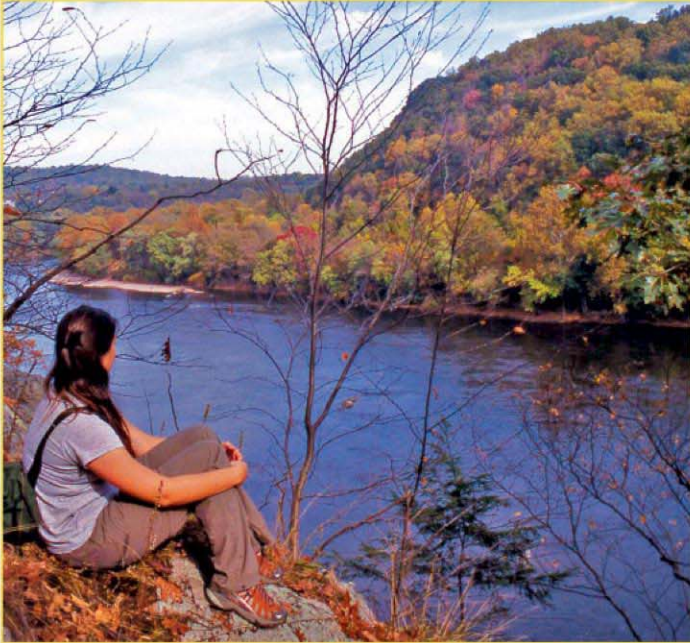

Directions to Mariton Wildlife Sanctuary



From Rt. 611 go to Spring Hill Rd. just north of Rieglesville. Go west on Spring Hill Rd. for 0.6 miles to Sunnyside Lane. Turn right on Sunnyside Lane and go 0.5 miles to Mariton Wildlife Sanctuary entrance.

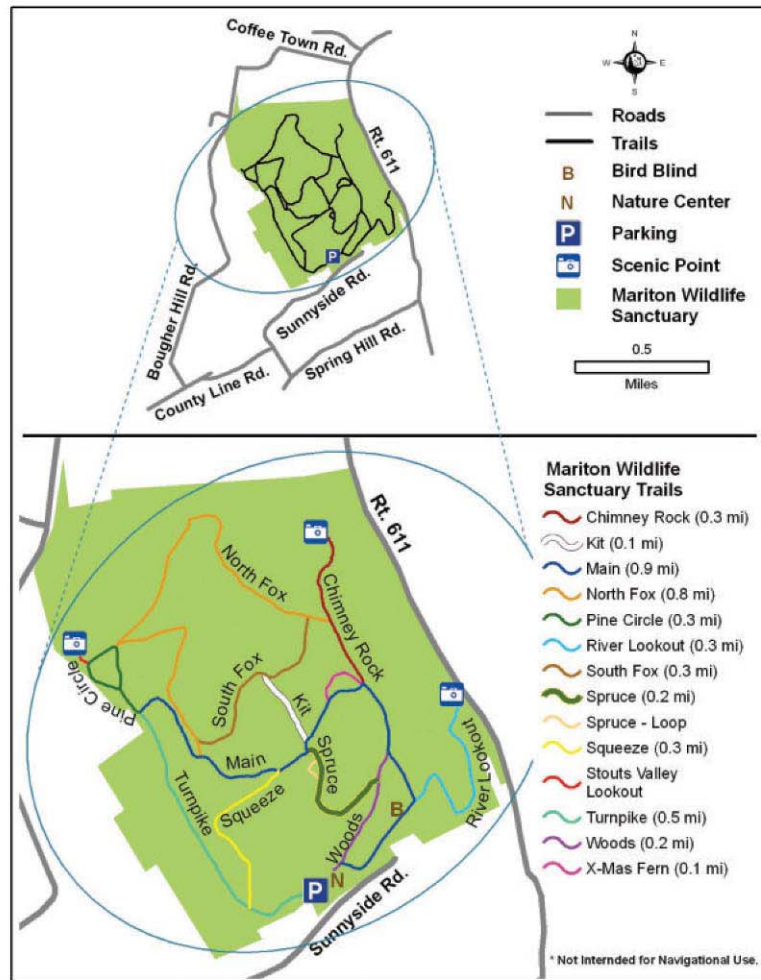

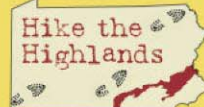
Mariton Wildlife Sanctuary

The 200-acre **Mariton Wildlife Sanctuary** sits on the slopes of Bougher Hill above Stouts Valley to the west and the Delaware River to the east. The preserve is home to a variety of mammals, birds, and reptiles, and has more than 425 species of plants, trees, vines, and shrubs. The forest here is dominated by oak, sweet birch, and tulip poplar and opens into a few small meadows on the hill tops. There are approximately four miles of trails suitable for various physical abilities. There is also a dramatic overlook where steep cliffs drop off to the Delaware River.
