



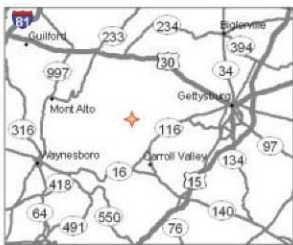

Directions to Strawberry Hill Nature Preserve



From downtown Gettysburg, PA at the junction of Rt. 15 Business and Rt. 116, go west on Rt. 116 for 7.1 miles to Bullfrog Rd. Turn right and go 0.4 mile to Mt. Hope Rd. Go straight across Carrols Tract Rd. onto Mt. Hope Rd. Go 2.8 miles to Strawberry Hill Nature Preserve.

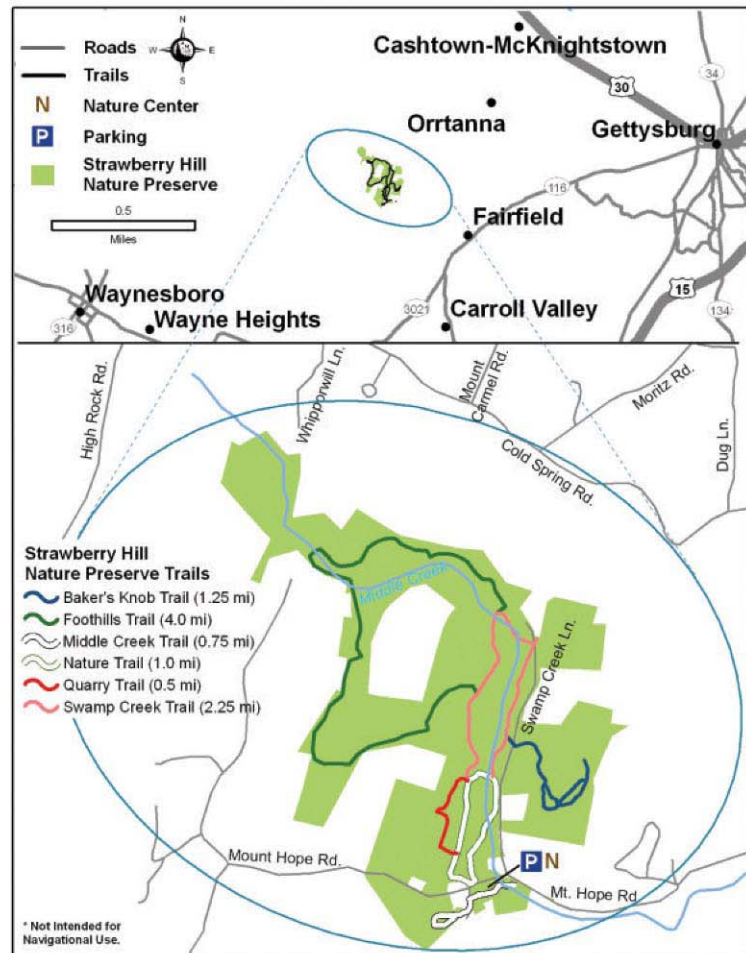


SOUTH MOUNTAIN CONSERVATION AREA

Strawberry Hill Nature Preserve is a private non-profit education and conservation institution located in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains of Adams County. More than 10 miles of trails meander through the property, leading to unique rock formations, scenic vistas, and secret glades. Trails range from easy streamside strolls suitable for families with young children to more rugged trails with some moderately steep sections. Avid birders will enjoy the abundance of birding opportunities.
