Directions to Ralph Stover State Park



Ralph Stover State Park: From Rt. 32 go to Tohickon Hill Rd. Go west on Tohickon Hill Rd. 0.9 mile to State Park Rd. Turn right and go 1.1 miles to the parking lot.

Ralph Stover State Park

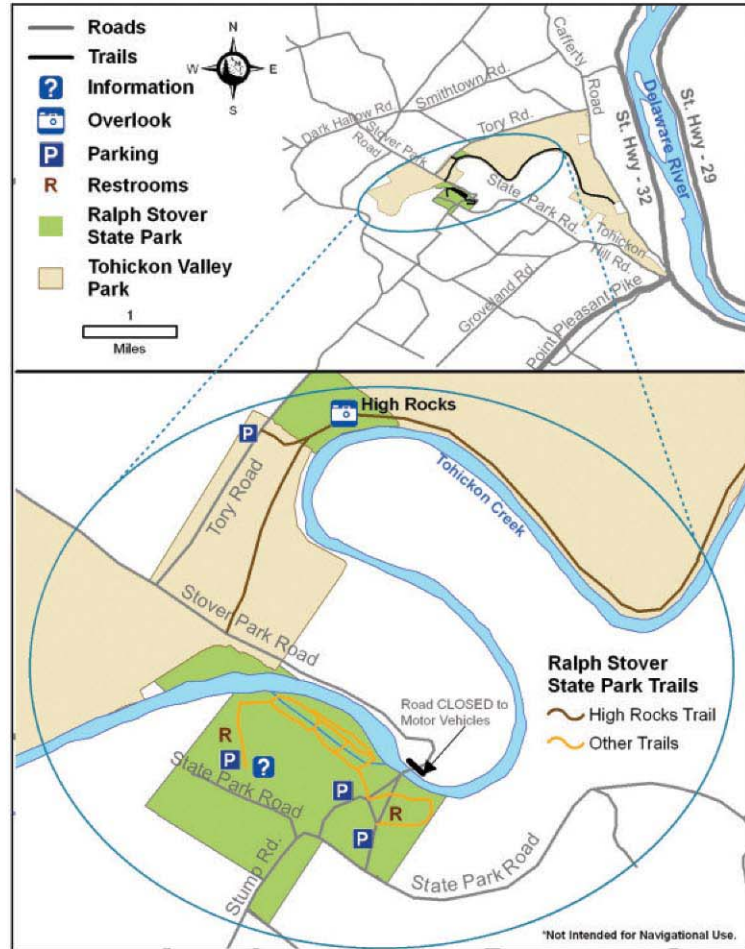
Ralph Stover State Park was the site of an 18th century water-powered grist mill. Today, the park connects to Tohickon Valley Park and provides access to the "High Rocks" vista of the Tohickon Creek. The trail, from the Ralph Stover parking lot along the scenic Tohickon Creek to the High Rocks vista, is a half-mile gradual hill on a paved or hard packed surface. High Rocks has interesting geological features, views of the Tohickon Creek Valley, and a 200-foot sheer rock face for experienced climbers. This area is fenced in for safety and some of the trails are rocky and require hiking footwear. There is an additional parking lot at Tory Rd.
