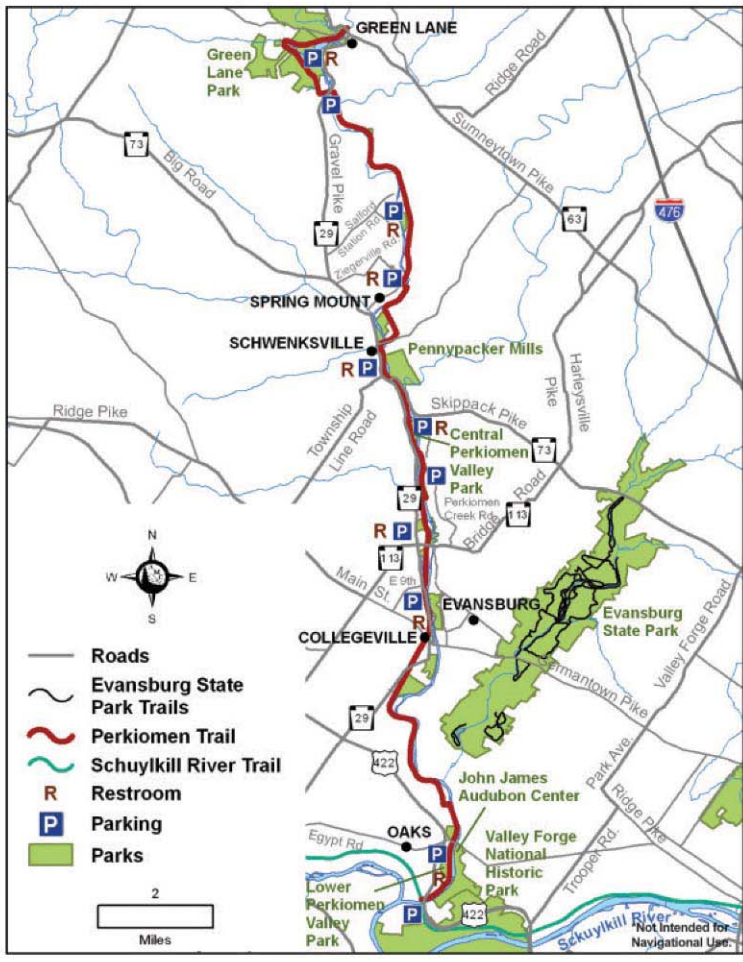

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UNAMI HILLS CONSERVATION AREA Perkiomen Trail

The 20-mile multi-use **Perkiomen Trail** follows the scenic Perkiomen Creek connecting Lower Perkiomen Valley Park, Central Perkiomen Park, and Green Lane Park, as well as the historic Mill Grove and Penny-packer Mills. The trail passes through some of the most beautiful areas of Montgomery County, from town centers to rural, remote areas. Most of the Perkiomen trail is a 12-foot wide cinder or stone aggregate surface with grass shoulders making the trail accessible to all ability levels. The trail also connects to the Schuylkill River Trail.

Directions to the Perkiomen Trail



Central section: From Rt. 422, go north on Rt. 29 for 6.3 miles to Plank Rd. Turn right and go 0.1 mile to Central Perkiomen Valley Park. The central section of the Perkiomen Trail is 10 miles from the end of the northern (Green Lane Park) and the southern (Schuylkill Trail) sections of the trail.
